Sub: Truing up of Average Pooled Power Purchase Cost [APPC] for the Financial Year 2025-26 and notifying provisional APPC for the Year 2026-27-reg.

Preamble:

The Commission vide its Order dated 07.04.2026 has trued up the APPC for FY2025-26 and has also determined the provisional APPC for FY2026-27.

Hence, the following Notification. -

- i. In exercise of the powers conferred under Clause 7 (c) of the KERC (Procurement of Energy from Renewable Sources) Regulations, 2011, for the purpose of Renewable Energy Certificate (REC), the Karnataka Electricity Regulatory Commission, hereby, notifies the APPC at Rs.6.73 per unit for the financial year 2026-27 with effect from 01.04.2026, which is subject to truing up, as per the actuals.
- ii. In accordance with the KERC (Procurement of Energy from Renewable Sources) (Seventh Amendment) Regulations, 2019, for FY27, the ESCOMs shall bill the RE generators selling energy to them under REC mechanism at lower of Rs.6.73/unit or 75% of the Generic tariff determined for FY27 by the Commission, for the respective RE source, which is subject to truing up of APPC for FY27.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 18, 52, 55, 56 and 66 and read with section 123 of the Mental Healthcare Act, 2017 (Central Act 10 of 2017), the Karnataka State Mental Health Authority hereby makes the following regulations, namely:-

REGULATIONS
CHAPTER-I
PRELIMINARY

1. Title, commencement and application. - (1) These regulations may be called the Karnataka State Mental Healthcare Regulations, 2026.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definitions. (1) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, -

(a) **"Act"** means the Mental Health Care Act, 2017 (Central Act 10 of 2017);

(b) **"Annexure"** means an Annexure appended to these regulations;

(c) **"Chair-person"** means Chair-person of the State Authority under clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 46 of the Act;

(d) **"Chief Executive Officer"** means the Chief Executive Officer of the State Authority appointed under Rule 9 of the Karnataka Mental Health care Rules, 2021;

(e) **"Form"** means a form appended to these regulations;

(f) **"Occupational therapist"** means a person having a bachelor's degree in occupational therapy by an university established by law;

(g) **"Psychologist"** means a person having degree or Postgraduate degree in any of the sub specialties of psychology;

(h) **"Social worker"** means a person having degree or Postgraduate degree in social work;

(i) **"Rules"** means the Karnataka Mental Health Care Rules, 2021;

(j) **"Section"** means section of the Act;

(k) **"State Authority"** means the Karnataka State Mental Health Authority established under section 45 of the Act;

(l) **"State Government"** means the Government of Karnataka; and

(m) **"Yoga therapist"** means a person having a Bachelor Degree or Postgraduate degree or Postgraduate diploma in yoga therapy from an University established by law and accredited by the relevant professional body.

(3) The words and expressions used in these regulations but not defined shall have the same meaning assigned to them in the Act.

CHAPTER-II

The Minimum Quality Standards of Mental Health Services and Registration

3. The minimum quality standards of mental health services under sub-section (9) of section 18.- In Karnataka, Mental Health Establishments are broadly divided into following five categories based on Central Mental Health Authority Notification New Delhi dated 12th August 2025 : -

(a)	Standalone Mental Health Establishments	Category - A
(b)	Psychiatric Department of Medical Colleges	Category- B
(c)	Psychiatric Wards of Multi-specialty Hospitals	Category -C
(d)	Standalone De-addiction Centres	Category -D
(e)	Centres for Psychosocial Rehabilitation	Category- E

(1) The Category A -Mental Health Establishment (Standalone Mental Health Establishments)

- a) shall have a standalone and dedicated center for providing in-patient mental health services, without being part of a general or multi-specialty hospital setup;
- b) may include standalone central and state mental hospitals or institutes, private mental hospitals or institutes, and psychiatric nursing homes;
- c) may provide the following services, namely: -
 - i In-patient care, which may include acute crisis intervention, long-term care, and treatment for substance use disorders;
 - ii Comprehensive psychiatric services, including diagnostics, pharmacological and psychosocial interventions, and rehabilitation components.

(2) The Category B- Mental Health Establishment (Psychiatric Department of Medical Colleges)

- a) shall have in-patient facility as part of the psychiatric departments of medical colleges, providing integrated clinical and academic services;
- b) shall include in-patient psychiatric wards of government and private medical colleges;
- c) shall provide the following services, namely: -
 - i integrated academic and clinical structure of medical colleges, contributing to capacity building in mental health professions;

- ii clinical care, undergraduate/postgraduate training, and may engage in psychiatric research;
- iii integrated care for co-morbid psychiatric and physical health conditions;
- iv Outpatient services and emergency/crisis interventions.

(3) The Category C - Mental Health Establishment (Psychiatric Wards of Multi-specialty Hospitals)

- a) shall have a psychiatric unit or ward as part of general or multi-specialty hospitals, district mental health programme units and similar facilities, offering in-patient mental health services alongside other medical specialties;
- b) may include, in-patient psychiatric units, departments or wards within private multi-specialty hospitals and district mental health programme, district hospitals, sub-district or taluk hospitals and community health centers;
- c) may provide the following services, namely: -
 - (i) short to medium-term in-patient care;
 - (ii) integrated care for co-morbid psychiatric and physical health conditions;
 - (iii) outpatient services and emergency/crisis interventions.

(4) The Category D- Mental Health Establishment (Standalone De-addiction Centers)

- a) shall have a standalone or dedicated center for providing specialized in-patient services for substance use disorders, without being part of any other health or mental health institution or organization;
- b) shall include standalone de-addiction centers, including facilities such as integrated rehabilitation centers for addicts and addiction treatment facilities under the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment;
- c) shall also provide the services of short-term detoxification to long-term residential rehabilitation, offering acute detoxification, withdrawal management, and rehabilitation.

(5) The Category E- Mental Health Establishment (Centers for Psychosocial Rehabilitation)

- a) shall have a center for residential psychosocial rehabilitation and long-term community-based care for persons with mental healthcare needs,

- including support for activities of daily living, recovery, independent living, skill development and social reintegration;
- b) shall include quarter-way homes, halfway homes, and long-stay homes where overnight stay is provided;
- c) shall provide the following services, namely: -
- (i) life skills and vocational training, functional improvement and supportive residential environments;
 - (ii) independent living facilities, community reintegration, and long-term supported care”.

4. Registration of Establishments. - All private health clinic or medical establishments and Mental Health Establishments are required to be registered under the Karnataka Private Medical Establishments Act, 2007 (Karnataka Act 21 of 2007). Whereas the Mental Health Establishments shall also be registered under the Karnataka State Mental Health Authority according to the said Act.

Provided that the Mental Health Establishment falling under categories A to D shall register under Level 2 Hospitals and category E shall register under category 1B of the Private medical establishments specified in Karnataka Private Medical Establishment Rules 2009.

5. Standards to be followed by Mental Health Establishment. - All Mental Health Establishments whether it is Government or Private or run by any trust or any Co-operative society shall follow the norms and standards as prescribed in schedule to the Mental Health Care (Central Mental Health Authority) Regulations, 2020 and in addition, the Mental Health Establishments shall follow the additional standards and norms specified in the Annexure.

CHAPTER-III

Officers and Staff, Salaries and Allowances and other terms and conditions of the State Authority

6. Officers and staff of the State Authority. - The State Authority under sub-sections (1), (2) and (3) of section 52 of the Act may, with the approval of the State Government, notify the number, nature and categories of other officers and employees required by the State Authority in the discharge of its functions.

7. The method of recruitment. - The method of appointment, qualification, experience, if any, of the officers and employees of State Authority shall be

governed by the respective rules applicable to similar posts of State Government. The State Authority shall appoint the officers and employees of the Authority other than Chief Executive Officer.

8. Conditions of Services. - The salaries and allowances payable to and all other terms and conditions of service of officers and employees of the State Authority shall be governed by the respective rules applicable to similar posts in the state Government and shall be the same as specified by State Government from time to time.

CHAPTER-IV

Meetings of the State Authority

9. Meetings of State Authority as per sub-section (1) of section 56 of the Act.- (1) The meeting of the State Authority shall generally be held at Bengaluru:

Provided that, the Chairperson may decide any other place for meeting if the circumstances render it expedient to hold the meeting at any other place in the State.

(2) The State Authority shall meet not less than four times in a year.

Provided that, the Chairperson may also call a special meeting at any time to deal with any urgent matter requiring the attention of the Authority.

10 Notice for meeting. -Every notice calling for a meeting of the State Authority shall,-

(i) specify there in the place, date and time of the meeting;

(ii) be served upon every member of the State Authority not less than seven days prior to the day appointed for the meeting:

Provided that, the Chairperson may call a special meeting at any time.

11. Agenda for the meeting.-Along with the notice for the meeting of the State Authority, the Chief Executive Officer shall prepare and circulate to the members of the State Authority an agenda for such meeting, with the approval of the Chairperson.

12. Quorum.- The quorum of the meeting of the State Authority shall be three members as per sub-section (2) of section 76 the Act.

13. Online meeting. - (1) Any member of the State Authority may join the meeting through video conferencing during the specified time, and he shall have same rights and responsibilities as members attending the meeting in person.

(2) The member attending the meeting through video-conferencing shall also constitute the quorum.

14. Urgent issues.- Any business which is to be placed before the State Authority for decision but which cannot wait for the next meeting due to urgent nature, the Chairperson or the member authorized by him shall record such a decision in writing and every such decision shall be ratified in the next meeting of the State Authority.

15. Conduct of meetings.-(1) the meeting shall be called to order by the Chairperson.

(2) The Chairperson or the member who presides over the meeting shall decide the sequence of the agenda items for consideration.

(3) Save as otherwise provided in these regulations, the Chief Executive Officer may invite a non-member to the meeting as a special invitee, with the permission of the Chairperson.

16. Attendance and proceedings at meetings. -(1) The Chief Executive Officer shall record the attendance of members at the meeting in the attendance register maintained for the purpose by the secretariat of the Authority, and in electronic attendance in case of online meeting.

(2) The Chief Executive Officer shall record the attendance of non- members in the minutes of the meeting.

(3) The Authority may grant leave of absence to a member not present in the meeting and the Chief Executive Officers shall record such leave of absence in the minutes of the meeting.

17. Minutes of the meetings. -(1) The Chief Executive Officer shall record the minutes of the meeting of the Authority.

(2) The Chairperson or the Member presiding the meeting shall approve the minutes of the meeting recorded by the Chief Executive Officer, and the Chief Executive Officer shall circulate the same to the members within a fortnight of the meeting.

(3) The Chief Executive Officer shall cause the approved minutes of the meeting be authenticated and maintained by signatures of the Chairperson or the member who chaired the meeting.

(4) The Chief Executive Officer shall communicate the relevant extracts of the decision of the Authority to all the members for necessary follow up action and monitor their compliance by evolving a suitable reporting system.

(5) The Chief Executive Officer shall submit an action taken report on the decisions of the last meeting in the next meeting.

18. Proceedings of the meeting. - The Chief Executive Officer shall forward the copy of the proceedings of each meeting of the State Authority, to the State Government.

CHAPTER-V

Registration of the Mental Health Establishment

19. Permanent registration under sub-section (12) of Section 66 of the Act.- (1) Every Mental Health Establishment in the State of Karnataka seeking permanent registration shall apply to the State Authority in Form - A along with the evidence to show that the Mental Health Establishments complies with all minimum standards specified in the Annexure along with a fees specified in the table below by way of electronic payment or demand draft drawn in favour of the Chief Executive Officer, State Mental Health Authority payable at Bangaluru or at such other place as may be specified by the Authority,-

Sl no	Category of Mental Health Establishment	Fee for Permanent Registration (in rupees)
1	Up to 50 beds	5,000/-

(2) The validity of permanent registration of a Mental Health Establishment shall be for a period of five years subject to renewal thereafter.

(3) Every Mental Health Establishment shall be subject to periodical inspection regarding the compliance of the Minimum standards specified in the Annexure

(4) In case any Mental Health Establishment fails to comply with the minimum standards or on receipt of complaint, it is found that it has violated the minimum standards, the Authority may cancel the registration or keep under suspension, after due Show Cause notice to the Mental Health Establishment. The establishment shall also be liable for such penalty as provided in the Act.

20. Filing of Objection for grant of permanent registration: - Any person may file an objection to the State Authority in writing or through online manner against the grant of permanent registration to a Mental Health Establishment in response to public notice within the time specified in the notice.

CHAPTER-VI

Mental Health Professionals

21. List of Mental Health Professionals. The list of Mental Health Professionals registered under Rules 15 and 16 of the Karnataka State Mental Health Care Rules, 2021 and whose name are maintained in register in "FORM E" of the said rules shall be published on the official web site of the Authority.

22. Complaints.-Any person aggrieved by a Mental Health Establishment may file a complaint against it to the Authority in writing or through online manner.

Standard 1: The premises and Physical infrastructure shall have -

- a) Entrance to the facility:
- b) Access to the facility shall be comfortable for the patient and/or attendants/visitors. Access shall be provided within the requirements of "Persons with Disabilities Act" and shall be easy for all those whose mobility may be restricted due to whatever cause.
- c) The building shall have a board displaying the name of the facility, name of care provider with registration number, registration details of the facility under Karnataka State Mental Health Authority (KSMHA) and Karnataka Private Mental Establishment, timings of service, different service provided, contact address of Karnataka State Mental Health Authority and Mental Health Review Board at a prominent location.
